

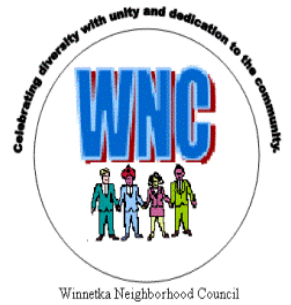

Furthermore, the Public Works & Transportation Committee of the Winnetka Neighborhood Council recommends the installation of faux red brick motifs in the crosswalks of the following intersections for the beautification of the Winnetka Business District. Winnetka Ave / Saticoy St; Saticoy St / Oso Avenue. (Motion by art Sims, Second by Edwina Hollins. Motion passed 5-0)
