Dear Councilmember Zine:

I am contacting you to follow up on your offer to assist Neighborhood Councils within your District to post solar powered speed signs. At the last President's Meeting at your office you reiterated your support to split the \$6000.00 cost to post these signs with any NC that was interested.

Our Board discussed this at length at our December 2008 regular Board meeting and decided that there are four locations where we would like to see these signs posted. As a result, the WNC passed the following motion:

"The WNC approves up to \$12,000.00 to be allocated to split the cost of four solar powered speed signs at the following locations: DeSoto Ave (between Roscoe and Sherman Way, on the East side), Winnetka Ave (between Sherman Way and Strathern Ave on the west side), Saticoy Ave (between Winnetka Ave and Mason Ave, on the South side), and Roscoe (between Winnetka Ave and DeSoto Ave, near Oso, on the south side)."

The WNC feels these signs will help deter motorists from speeding along these routes. If we can slow down just one car, and prevent just one accident these funds will be spent well.

I look forward to hearing from your office on this issue.
