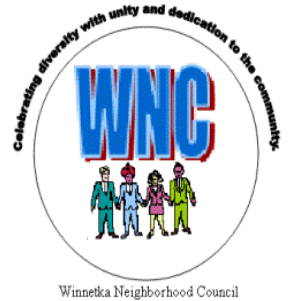

6.1. Ms. Robinson said that this is in conjunction with the WNC Public Safety, Canoga Park, and Reseda.

6.2. Mr. Lace asked for clarification on what this was. He also asked if there was an age limit.

6.3. Mr. Popowich said there is likely an age limit.

6.4. Ms. Robinson also commented that Bubba from the LAFD still needs to come to Valley Village to check to see if the facility will work.

6.5. Mr. Lace asked if CERT will do training for high school age children. He is aware of a few local high schools

6.10. Motion passed: 4-0.

7. Discussion and possible action on the WNC Cable pilot program. (Jurgenson). This may include action on content, costs, and/or other resources needed to carry this program out.

7.1. Ms. Robinson commented that Mr. Jurgenson is working on the production portion of the process. He is working with Time Warner on scheduling production time.

7.2. Mr. Lace said he discussed this with the City to find out how we can allocate funds on hand to pay for an item. He said the City would allow a bill for future services and the funds would be released to the WNC to carry this out.

8. Discussion and possible action on participation in Big Sunday, on May 7, 2006. This is a West Valley clean up effort lead by Mayor Villaraigosa.

8.1. Ms. Robinson passed out a flyer. Originally she said this was for just Reseda High. However, she discussed this with the Mayor’s office and said that the WNC probably not participate since it was outside of Winnetka. The Mayor’s office has agreed to allow us to locate a project in Winnetka and we can do it under this banner.

8.2. Mr. Popowich suggested we purchase 20 large planters and place them along Saticoy from Winnetka to Mason as an effort to beautify the area. We can ask the City to provide trees for the planters. We can make this our project for Winnetka.

“WNC-OE-032706-04: WNC will allocate up to \$6000.00 for the purchase of the large planters. The planters will be placed along Saticoy, from Winnetka & Mason. The WNC will ask the Mayor’s office to provide drought resistant plants for the planters to be planted on Big Sunday, May 7, 2006. (Popowich)”
